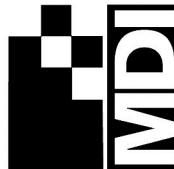

Greene County Mental Health Court

The Greene County Mental Health Court just celebrated their 10 year anniversary. The purpose of the program is to serve offenders with co-occurring disorders, developmental disabilities, or head injury in the criminal justice system. The core element of this program is an integrated system approach that can bring together the various agencies within the community to address the offenders' needs and to teach the essential skills necessary for changing their behaviors. The offenders will work closely with the Court and assigned treatment team to facilitate positive behavioral changes and program compliance.
